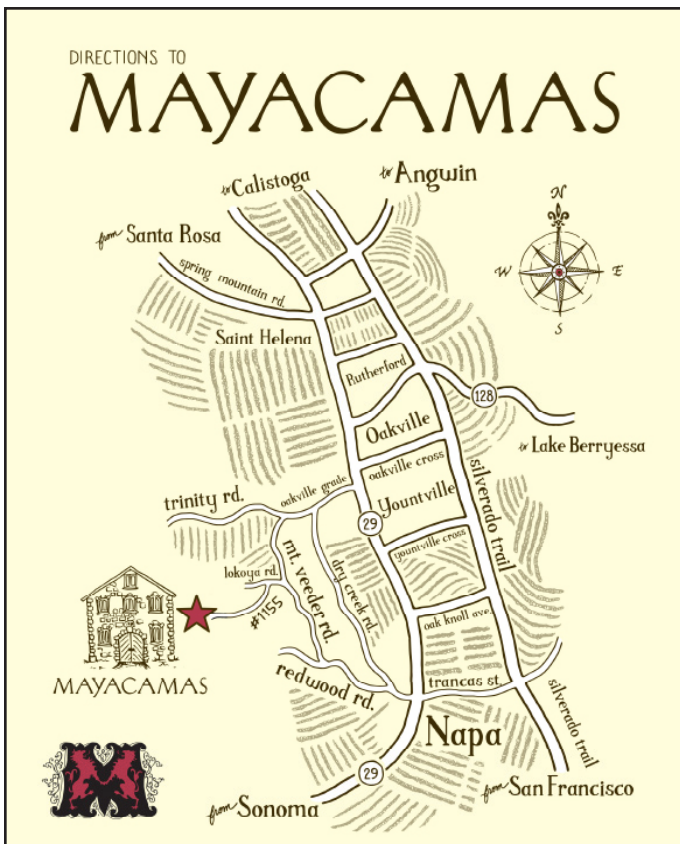


Mayacamas Vineyards

We look forward to hosting you! Please do not rely on GPS or Google Maps—service often fails in the mountains! We are located about 30 minutes from Napa and 45 minutes from St. Helena.

GETTING HERE: FROM NAPA (SOUTH)

- Traveling north on Highway 29 in Napa, take the “Redwood Road/Trancas Street,” exit 19. Turn left (west) onto Trancas Street and cross over the highway, where Trancas Street becomes Redwood Road.
- Follow Redwood Road west as it eventually turns into a winding mountain road. About 4 miles from the highway Redwood Road splits to the left and Mt. Veeder Road continues straight. Do not turn left—continue on Mt. Veeder Road.
- Continue straight ahead onto Mt. Veeder Road for about 4 more crooked/elevated miles to Lokoya Road, located precisely at mile marker 4.25. Turn left onto Lokoya Road.
- About 1/2 mile up Lokoya Road there are 13 mail boxes on the left. Turn left just past the mailboxes onto our dirt road, marked by an 1155 sign.
- Follow this dirt road all the way up the hill (about 1/2 mile), past “WILD CAT MTN. VINEYARD.”
- Mayacamas Vineyards will be straight ahead, travel time is about 30 minutes from Napa.



GETTING HERE: FROM ST. HELENA (NORTH)

- Traveling south on Highway 29 you will come to the town of Oakville ~5 miles south of St. Helena.
- At the south end of Oakville, turn right (west) onto the “Oakville Grade.” Drive about 3.5 miles into the hills and you will come to an intersection marked by a “Mt. Veeder Appellation” sign on the left. Do not turn left here (this is Dry Creek Road). Continue past this intersection and past the Mount Veeder-Lokoya Fire Station you will see on your right. Continue past Clear Creek Road. The next street is Mt. Veeder road—turn left onto Mt. Veeder Road.
- Continue for about 4 more crooked/elevated miles (addresses will descend from the 4000s to the 2300s) and make a very sharp right turn onto Lokoya Road.
- About 1/2 mile up Lokoya Road there are 13 mailboxes on the left. Turn left just past the mailboxes onto our dirt road, marked by an 1155 sign.
- Follow this dirt road all the way up the hill (about 1/2 mile), past “WILD CAT MTN. VINEYARD.”
- Mayacamas Vineyards will be straight ahead, travel time is about 45 minutes from St. Helena.

PARKING, ETC

We may be unable to host your group if you are more than 20 minutes late, so please be sure to keep us posted regarding your arrival (707-224-4030).

Parking will be in the gravel driveway at the stone cottage on your left as you drive towards the winery. There may or may not be another car already there, but there are two exits.
